



## **College Park Village Association Scholarship School Year 2023 - 2024**

Thanks to the generosity of our community and countless volunteer hours provided from our residents, The College Park Village Association will award a \$1,000.00 scholarship for the 2023 - 2024 school year. The scholarship will be awarded to a student that resides within the Village of College Park. The Village of College Park includes the neighborhood communities of Grogan's Forest, Windsor Hills, and Harper's Landing and the apartment complexes of Plantation Apartments and Pine Creek Ranch.

The scholarship will be based on academic excellence, artistic or athletic talent, participation in extracurricular activities, community service, financial need, or other factors.

Special interest will be given to applicants with community service such as involvement in non-profit organizations, membership in local or area clubs or chapters, a member of groups whose activities benefit the community, or providing individual volunteer service to benefit our community. Individual interviews with applicants may be held to assist the scholarship committee in their final selection. The winner and their Career Counselor will be notified in the beginning of May. The scholarship check will be mailed directly to the school in which the applicant enrolls during the summer. Should the winning applicant fail to enroll in a school of advanced studies within a reasonable length of time, after careful deliberation of the committee, the scholarship may be revoked and awarded to an alternate applicant.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must be a current resident of the Village of College Park and a graduating senior (12<sup>th</sup> grade). Instructions for submitting the application have been included in this packet.
