

**College Park Village Association
July Meeting Minutes
July 17, 2017**

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM by President Ted Stanley. Members present were, Secretary Marti Meerscheidt, Treasurer Dave Mulberry, Vice President Mike Larson and area representatives Jake Miller and Ken Morris. Members absent were Johanne Stanley, Joel Barnes, and Steve LaMotta. Regular contributors present were Village Liaison Peggy Krysiak and Deputy Coroiescu. Also present was MCSO officer Chris Forman. Pledge of Allegiance was followed by the **MCSO report presented** by Deputy Stephanie Coroiescu. She reported on feature captives for the month of June. She presented trends in law enforcement matters. Statistics for the month included 415 vacation watches in College Park and 82 arrests over all. 2. Residents Comments - none

3. Township Report was presented by Peggy Krysiak and a list of highlights were provided. Information available on the Township web site.

4. Village Liaison Peggy Krysiak provided a list of Neighborhood Watch events that included public safety events and National Night Out scheduled for Sunday October 8. Fliers were available. She reported that the Fire Station 6 Good Neighbor Day was attended by 16 residents. She encouraged all to attend the Boots and Badges softball game on August 6 at 7 PM.

5. Administrative Reports: Minutes for June were sent via email by Marti Meerscheidt. Minutes approved unanimously by a motion from Dave and seconded by Ken after a correction was made in last month's members present. **Treasurer's Report** was presented by Dave. Positive variances were noted and it was requested that we discuss moving positive variances from completed events to other upcoming event budgets such as National Night Out and Poolooza. This discussion will be on next month's agenda.

6. Village Activities: July 4th activities – location of tent was at our usual location. Steve and Ted set up the tent. Marti was joined by her neighbors the Saboda's and Mike brought his daughter-in-law and grandchildren. Those of us there enjoyed ourselves. **NNO** is October 8 in College Park and October 17 at Windsor Hills. Mike will contact K-star for local entertainment available. Mike would like to have the bicycle parade again. We will talk about getting the hot dog vendor at the next meeting. Peggy elaborated on the change of date for NNO from August to October and this year making it on a Sunday.

7. Other Village Business: Discussion of Village website - Again, our website is for static information and Facebook will be for dynamic information. As our Facebook connections grow we can add more reminders and more events. Mike is also working with The Woodlands online to add our events. It all seems to be working as we envisioned. We will continue to monitor usage and effectiveness. **Knightsbridge** is on the agenda for the August 2 DSC meeting. They will determine legal action to take if appropriate. Reports are that the homeowners have not changed anything. 74 residents in the area signed a petition to be presented at the August 2 meeting. **Bandit signs** - Residents have been picking up illegal signage (not approved by TW). Per the Sherriff's office there are employee who are trained to pick them up as per State laws.
